We Have News - The Friends of Milford are leaving Facebook

Due to recent changes in legislation, Facebook is no longer suitable for school correspondence.

We appreciate that for some this will be a surprise and Facebook has been a great place to receive news and befriend others within the school. Unfortunately, in order to comply with data protection regulations Mr.Stear and The Friends of Milford have had to conclude that Facebook is no longer fit for purpose. This means that we need to change the way we will be communicating with you.

New Application - Classlist

We will be moving to a new system that comes highly recommended and for similar reasons is used by lots of schools. The app is called ClassList.

ClassList is a dedicated application specifically designed for school use.

Benefits include:

Complies with the data protection act.

Closed site - Personal information and photos are more secure and less vulnerable to being shared on the internet. A safer and more inclusive way of contacting all parents.

ClassList has individual class forums where you can see news relevant to your child. There is also a whole school page and the main feed for broader school-wide announcements. One of the major draws is that parents will only need to check one place for all relevant information, rather than several Facebook groups.

When you sign up to ClassList users can change the settings and decide how to receive notifications. For example, you could decide to receive email, text or app notifications. You are also free to include as much or as little personal information as you choose.

Whilst we know that change always takes some adjusting to, we believe this is a big step towards protecting the children's data. We appreciate your support and welcome any questions you have.
