E-safety

I have been informed that during the period of closure, understandably, children have been playing more computer games. Please ensure that what the children are playing is age appropriate. Fortnite and other such battle games are not appropriate for Infant age children and due to social features, mean that children can potentially be put at risk. I hope you can support this and double check that any content the children have access to is age appropriate and has good security features enabled. As shops are starting to open again, o2 do offer a free service where they will check any device security settings so do take them up on it if it is of interest. Other than that, if you are unsure about the appropriateness of any apps or software, you can find lots of information online, including organisations such as 'internet safety matters' to name but one.

Pod spaces

Unfortunately we no longer have any spaces available for children to return. Over the last week we have been able to open an 8th pod to accommodate children that wanted to return, however that is now completely full. We are running 8 classrooms now and have no further staff to assign. I appreciate this may be disappointing to some of you however please rest assured that we will continue to provide home learning through Google Classroom and hope to confirm arrangements for more children to return in September. 
