Perform drama company drama and dance sessions	£1320	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All children had the chance to participate in drama and dance with a specialist teacher. Class teachers were present for all sessions and took ideas to use in their own lessons.
Learning Support Assistant time to fund an additional lunchtime play assistant to undertake organised sporting activities in the Summer term	£1000	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> More children were involved in sporting activities at lunchtimes leading to increased participation for all.
