

## Sport Premium Overview 2015 -2016 and 2016/17

At Milford School, we believe P.E. & Sport plays an important role in helping our children to Grow, Learn, Believe and Achieve.

In June 2013 the Secretary of State for Education pledged to provide **additional funding for 2 years** to improve provision of physical education (PE) and sport in primary schools.

We are committed to using this resource in developing **high quality PE lessons**, alongside greater opportunities for sporting competitions and clubs for all our young people.

## **Sport Premium Grant:**

Funding for schools will be based on a lump sum of £8,000, plus an additional £5 per pupil calculated by the number of primary aged pupils between the ages of 5 and 11.
