All parents/guardians will:

- Ensure that your child attends school every day, arriving between 8:45 & 9:00 unless there is a good reason for absence (e.g. illness)
- Ensure that your child comes to school fully prepared for a day of learning (fed, watered and with correct equipment book bag, PE kit, reading record)
- Ensure your child is collected on time at 3.15pm

- Notify the school by telephone in the event of absence by 9.30am
- Support the school's policies and guidelines on learning, behaviour and uniform
- Follow school rules and guidance, park considerately around the school and not in the staff car park without prior permission and support our "no riding" policy within the grounds



- Attend parent/teacher meetings to discuss your child's progress each term or make alternative arrangements to see the class teacher

- > Promptly inform the school of any concerns or problems that may affect your child's learning, behaviour or happiness at school
