SAFEGUARDING TOPIC ADVERSE CHILDHOOD EXPERIENCES (ACE)

What are ACE's?

We all have our 'oops' parenting moments which are completely normal and not a concern. However, when a child experiences **strong**, **frequent and/or prolonged** high levels of stress caused by:

- physical or emotional abuse
- daily neglect, drug and alcohol abuse
- mental illness
- domestic abuse
- poverty with little family support
 Experiencing ACE's can impact a child's brain
 development, resulting in sickness and loss of
 brain function into adulthood.
