Track and trace

On the 8th December the government sent Headteachers an email with the expectation that we will support track and trace for 6 days following the end of term. In effect this means that I must be available to contact parents/classes in the event of a positive case up to and including Christmas Eve.

If a pupil or staff member tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms within 48 hours of being in school, the school is asked to assist in identifying close contacts and advising self-isolation, as the individual may have been infectious whilst in school.

Where a pupil or staff member tests positive for coronavirus (COVID-19), having developed symptoms more than 48 hours since being in school, then you must follow contact tracing instructions provided by NHS Test and Trace, which may also involve informing the school.

To assist with this I have setup an email account for this purpose:

trackandtrace@milford.surrey.sch.uk

This will be checked daily between 7am and 9am. Please inform me immediately should your child test positive for Covid 19 within the 48hr timeframe stated above or if NHS Test and Trace advises you to.

Should this happen, any parents of children affected will be contacted by school via email and text message. You will then be required to self-isolate as per government guidelines. With that in mind, if you have recently changed mobile phone number, please let the office know as soon as possible. Thank you.

School Uniform

Please ensure that your child wears our school uniform each day. Lots of children do this and they look really smart and show great pride - look smart, feel smart! Recently though quite a few children have not been wearing appropriate footwear. Please ensure that your child wears footwear in line with our policy as stated on our website.

As you may also be aware, as part of our Eco-Schools work, we have launched our 'nearly new' school uniform shop online. We have a range of items available to purchase including book bags, PE bags, jumpers, cardigans and trousers. As well as being a sustainable venture, purchasing extra items of uniform in this way provides additional funding to the school to enable us to continue providing the best possible experiences for our children whilst at Milford School.

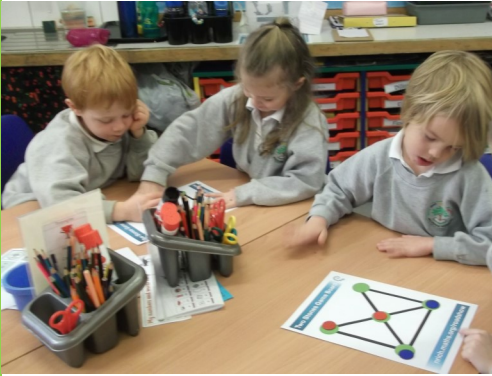

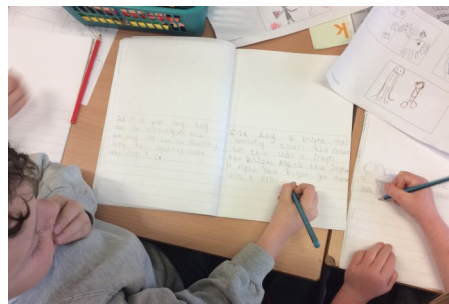
Fun in Year One!
